

Grade Distribution Charts from SIMS .net

Login to SIMS .net

Select **Focus | Assessment | Marksheet Entry**

Type **K** in the Template Name box and click  Search

The grade distribution charts can be generated on any of the following marksheets:


- **KS3 A. English TA: Year 10**
- **KS3 B. Maths TA: Year 10**
- **KS3 J. Broadsheet (Core): Curriculum Year 10**
- **KS3 J1. Broadsheet: Curriculum Year 10**

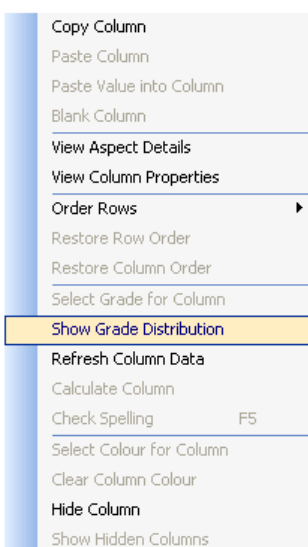
NB The marksheet **MUST** be for Year 10 and not an individual class marksheet.

If none of the above are listed then select **Focus | Assessment | Template** and assign a Year 10 marksheet to Template **KS3 J. Broadsheet (Core)**

1. English Grade Distribution for Year 10

Double click on the marksheet to bring it to open


Right click on column heading  and select **Show Grade Distribution**



The chart will show the Percentage of Results for each grade in English

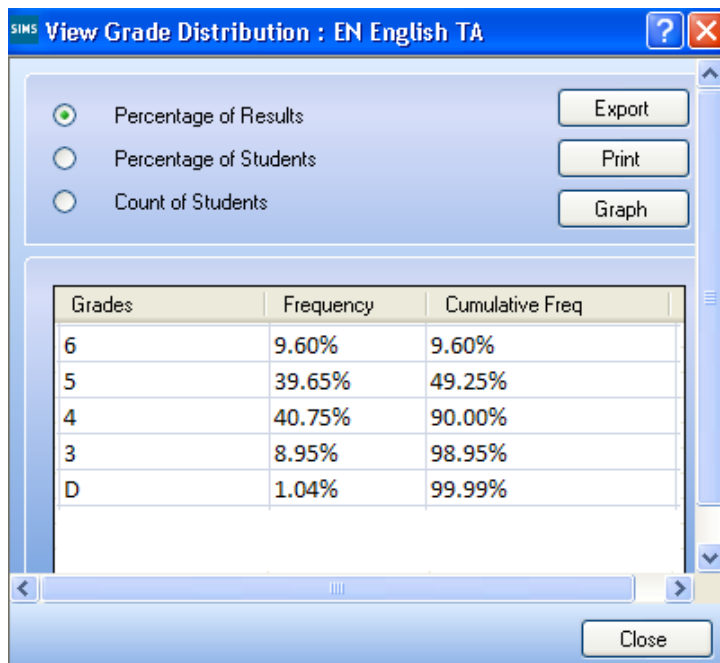
Click  or export to Excel and save to your user area

2. Maths Grade Distribution for Year 10

Right click on column heading  and select **Show Grade Distribution**

The chart will show the Percentage of Results for each grade in Maths

Click  or export to Excel and save to your user area



(NB The total Cumulative Frequency may not be exactly 100% due to rounding)

The **Frequency** column shows the percentage for each grade.

The **Cumulative Freq** column for Grade 5 will give the percentage of Year 10 students who have attained the expected level of 5 or above (example 49.25%).

For students working towards the expected level, add the frequencies for all levels less than 5, excluding Grade (example $40.75 + 8.95 = 49.70\%$)

The frequency for Grade D shows the percentage of Year 10 students exempted from assessment (example 1.04%).
