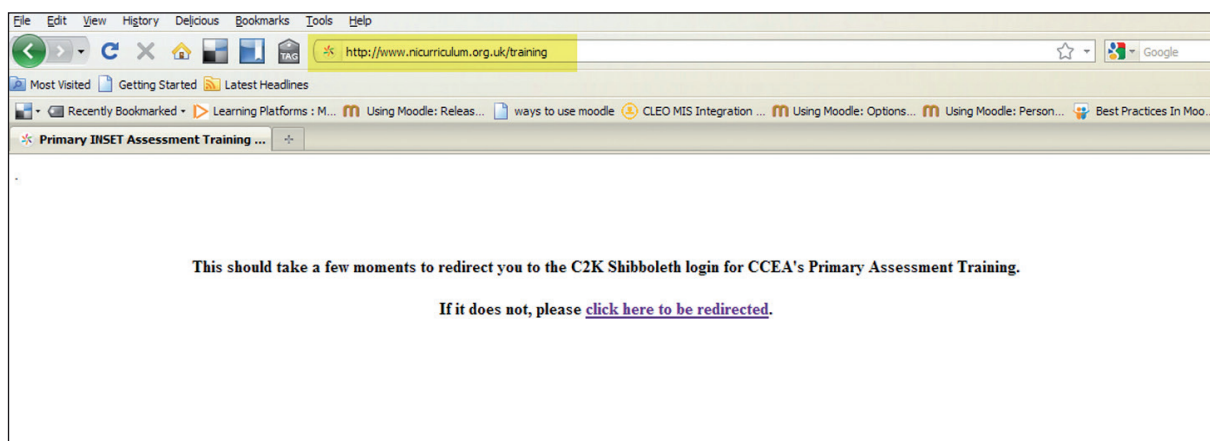
Accessing the Online Course

Step 1. Log in to the course

Open your web browser, for example Internet Explorer. In the web address bar (highlighted on the screen below), type:

www.nicurriculum.org.uk/training

Note: If you enter the course website address into Google or another search engine, you won't be able to log in to the course. Make sure you enter it as shown on the screen below.



It may take a few moments, but you will be redirected to the screen below. Use your C2k details to log in. (These are the details that you use to log in at school.)




