People who work in a garden centre might use a water sprinkler or a calculator.



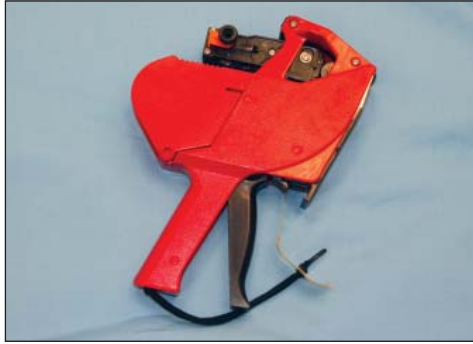
People who work in a charity shop might use a kettle or a cash register.
